### **Trial Site & Information**

The trial will be given in an indoor barn with a dirt floor. There is a small, heated office; the rest of the barn is unheated / not air-cond.

#### **Trial Site Rules**

- Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing or at the practice jump
- Competitors must pick up after their dog and deposit in facility trash cans.
- There is no food service available at the site. Only bottled water / light snacks will be available. Two Wawa's are within 3 miles distance.
- Please stay home if you feel sick but let the Trial Secretary know.

- 5 mph speed limit on the property.

**Crating: No indoor crating available. Plan to work out of your car.**

**Barn Location.** The location is convenient to Garden State Parkway exit 91 and US Route 9 Lakewood. Most will approach from County Line Road, turning North onto Ridge Ave, which changes name to Ramtown-Greenville Rd in Howell.

**Senior/ Champ runs first both days.**

**Agility, Jumping 1, Jumping 2, Open Snooker; Speedstakes.**

**Bitches in Season – May run at this trial. To be able to run a BIS, you must immediately tell the trial secretary. The BIS will remain in their running order who will mark BIS on the running orders. If the dog is not wearing BIS pants, they will start on a mat provided by the show. It is the handler's responsibility to ensure the mat is available for their runs. The handler/owner acknowledges the inherent risk of running a dog on an agility course with BIS pants on and assumes all risk by doing so.**

We depend on volunteers to make this a great event. All workers must check in with the Volunteer Coordinator at the show site to receive their work assignment and must have a qualifying assigned job in order to be eligible for:

- Worker credit if JAG member / potential member
- Any worker raffle entries

## **BY ENTERING UKI EVENTS, COMPETITORS AGREE TO:**

**UK Agility International Rules and Regulations** apply to the whole event and all people and dogs must comply with these at all times. As a competitor it is your responsibility to be aware of the rules and regulations as they stand at the time of the show. This show will run under the current edition UK Agility International rules found on the UKI web page. Each competitor acknowledges through their entry to the UKI event that their participation is a privilege and not a right.

Competitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of **UK Agility International rules and regulations** including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

**All dogs and handlers must be registered with UK Agility International to compete.** UK Agility International's official rules & regulations are available to view free from the UKI web page. If you or your dog is not already registered, please register online at [www.ukagilityinternational.com](http://www.ukagilityinternational.com)

All dogs are entered at this show at their owners' risk and whilst every care will be taken the show management and UKI will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property while at the UKI event.

Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete in UKI Trials, with the exception of dogs over 15 calendar months of age eligible to compete in Nursery Classes & Speedstakes classes.

A dog shall be withdrawn from competition without refund if it is: suffering from any infectious or contagious disease, interfering with the safety of any person or other animal or if it is likely to cause itself damage or its welfare is in danger if it continues competing.

It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children and guests. Any competitor whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, will at the discretion of the show management, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, guests from the event grounds. Any competitor or competitor's dogs that is dismissed from the show by the judge and/or show manager in accordance with UKI rules and regulations will have no recourse to any refund of fees paid as such entry fees, camping fees, crating fees and any other fees associated with the event.

It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Handlers working more than one dog in a class **must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn**. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

Dogs left in hot cars, or dogs appearing to be in distress, will be dealt with as seen fit by the Show Management.

Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge, the show management reserves the right to appoint another judge. Should circumstances so dictate the show manager, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to UK Agility International. In the event of abandonment of the show through circumstances beyond our control, the SHOW MANAGEMENT may defray such expenses from the entry fee to cover the cost of the show preparation. These accounts will then be made public.

### **Rules of Conduct:**

UKI promotes dog agility pursuant to regulations consistent with international standards as a competitive, spectator sport. All competitors, officials, and event personnel shall conduct themselves in a professional and sportsmanlike manner consistent with the foregoing statement of purpose and seek to uphold, and enhance where possible, the image of the sport and UKI through such conduct and actions including on social media platforms.

By virtue of their entry, competitors acknowledge and agree to comply with all UKI rules and regulations and agree to accept any sanctions that are imposed for failure to comply. The judge has responsibility for determining when it is appropriate to excuse a dog and competitor from the ring. The show officials have responsibility for determining when an infraction should result in a verbal warning, written warning and/or expulsion of a competitor, dog, or any person from the event by conducting

the procedure outlined in the UKI rule book. UKI head officials, through further investigation, may impose sanctions including suspension or expulsion from future events.

The following is a partial list of infractions on which the judge or trial officials will take action: Abuse of a dog on the grounds; actions that may have the appearance of abuse of a dog; willful misconduct or interference with a competitor's right to show; any acts of poor sportsmanship; violation of procedural rules; compulsive, correctional training on the grounds; willful misrepresentation on entry forms; willful misrepresentation of animals; dog aggression; failure to exercise diligence in the control of the behavior of their dog including a dog clearly not under the control of the handler ; concerns for the welfare of a dog or who is unfit for competing; intimidation and/or impolite confrontation of judges, event officials, event helpers, or other competitors; creating excessive delays as a failure to respect the authority of event officials.

### **Social Media Conduct**

Cyber bullying of any kind towards UKI, trial management & staff, competitors, judges, helpers or volunteers will not be tolerated. Examples of cyber bullying include but are not limited to, communications that seek to intimidate, manipulate, falsely discredit, put down, try to control, rudely confront, demand, and comments that try to incite further issues. Further, UKI is committed to maintaining an environment that is built on mutual respect and is free from racism, discrimination and harassment. In keeping with this goal, any behavior that is hateful towards race, color, religion, creed, national origin or ancestry, ethnicity, sex, and gender will not be tolerated. Any of these cases may sanction removal from all associated social media pages and even lead to expulsion of UKI events and even further expulsion of organization membership.

### **Refund and Entry Cancellation Policy**

Entries will not be accepted, changed, or altered after the closing date or capping level has been reached except for the purpose of moving to a higher level. A full refund is available for any membership that is not older than 14 days from the creation of the account date. A full refund is available before the closing date or capping level is met for any show. There will be no cost if refund money is to be left in your UKI account. If a refund is requested, a 5% administration fee for a credit card refund will be assessed, per transaction. ***After the closing date, a partial entry may be available for extraordinary circumstances, but this lies with the individual show management based upon their own policies. Contact the show management for details, NOT UKI.***

Payment of entry fees and Instant Account Top up Fees must be made directly to the UKI member account or directly to the trial before a competitor may compete. Once online entry closes, if you did not pay online, please be sure you have arranged for payment to be made directly to the show secretary. You are no longer allowed to pay online after the closing date. If you did not cancel your entry before the closing date, and choose not to attend, you will still owe your trial fees which must be paid directly to the trial secretary. The only way to cancel your online entry is before the closing date by logging into your account, selecting the trial that you want to cancel and selecting the button (cancel my entire entry). If you do not do this before the close date, you have NOT canceled your entry, and your entry fees are still due. UKI will suspend a handlers' registration and UKI account , until fees are paid in full

Additional administration charges may be imposed to a member's account due to negligence that result in administration time to correct. Possible infractions, not limited to, are submitting incorrect trial entry information, including incorrect handler and dog number, creating duplicate membership or dog accounts, and late payment fees. Charges are based on an hourly rate of \$20 per hour.

### **Media & Sponsor Rights Release**

Through the entry into this event, all competitors grant to UKI and its affiliated companies, representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media known now or in the future. Further, I hereby release UKI and its affiliates, representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right. Sponsors of UKI events may email entrants with their product and or service information. If a competitor does not wish to

receive emails from these sponsors, they must email the show management before the close of the trial entry date to declare this, ensuring they receive a receipt email that this information has been received by the trial management.

**Specific to this trial:**

SPEEDSTAKES is a class with just Jumps and Tunnels. The dog can be as young as 15 months on the day of the show to enter the Speedstakes class. Speedstakes Tournament means that the top scoring dog (details in final confirmation) in each jump height / class will win a prize. By entering you are automatically entered in the tournament

GAMBLERS is a class where first you make up a course to collect points, then perform one of two specified sequences

SNOOKER is a FUN game of skill that will be FULLY EXPLAINED by the judge so be sure to enter!

**GAMBLERS AND SNOOKER ARE \$10 each to enter to encourage you to enter BOTH!**

SNOOKER AND GAMBLERS are “open” meaning that everyone who enters runs the same course. You can plan your strategy with the more experienced handlers because they’ll be running the same course! (Scoring is still separate)

You don’t have to declare NFC when you enter the trial. You just have to declare it to the scribe and Judge as you enter the ring. You don’t have to do every run NFC; it is completely on a per-run basis.

JAG will be providing ribbons for this event. PMCC will have championship ribbons such as IAC, CSS, IWAC and WCSS.

We have now expanded the ring to use the whole depth of 120 feet in ring, so there will be no more crating/waiting in a fenced off area inside the barn except ‘next dog’. The dirt has been leveled and is watered daily.
